Visiting the Library

- Face masks are required for staff working in public spaces and for patrons 2 and older visiting the library
- Hand sanitizer is available throughout the library
- To allow for social distancing, the library is limiting the number of patrons in the building to 10 at a time. To help keep track of those entering the library, we are asking patrons to ring the doorbell for access into the building.
- The number of public computers available is limited to allow for social distancing
- We are asking that visits be kept to 30 minutes
- Children under 16 must be accompanied by an adult
- Curbside services for material, faxes, and copies are available
- Seating is limited, and toys and games are currently unavailable.

Employee Health

- Employees are self-screening and conducting temperature checks before reporting to work
- Employees with a fever of 100.4 or higher, or who are experiencing COVID symptoms are asked to stay home from work

Enhanced Cleaning

Building

- High-touch surfaces are sanitized regularly
- The library is closed to the public mid-day from 12-1 to allow for deeper cleaning of public spaces and restrooms

Material

- Returned library material is sanitized and quarantined for 24 hours

Equipment

- Public Computers are sanitized after each use
- Library staff will be making all patron copies/scans, and the machine will be sanitized regularly

Programs

- All in-person programs will return at a later date. We will continue to offer virtual programming and take home craft kits!
